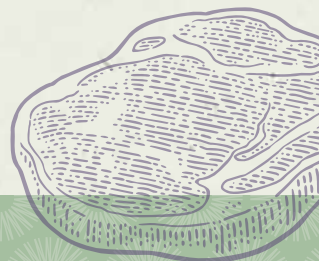
## DISTRICT NOTABLES

### FARM FRESH

The Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) has recognized the district's Child Nutrition Services Department for incorporating farm-to-table foods in its breakfast and lunch menus. The award-winning department connects with local farmers through TDA's Farm Fresh Program.

### MEAT MARKET

Florence High School is one of only a handful of high schools in Texas with a meat market program and the first to have a lab for processing meat. Through the program, students learn how to fully run a business, including preparation, packaging, marketing, and selling.
